Hotel La Mandarine is committed to acting for the environment.

This commitment involves learning and sharing eco-responsible knowledge and practices, both within our teams and among our guests. Our efforts and actions are structured around six distinct commitments:

1. Sharing a social and environmental policy with our staff

- Information sessions on environmental management are held twice a year for our employees, to train them in eco-responsible practices specific to their respective roles.
- Preference given to local contractors and craftsmen.
- Support for local initiatives related to sustainable development and solidarity.

2. Raising our guests' awareness of eco-responsible practices

- Waste sorting.
- Conservation of water and energy.
- Activities centred on sustainable tourism and organic farming.

3. Preserving energy and water

- Energy contracts developed with certified suppliers.
- Installation of energy-efficient appliances.
- Water flow restrictors installed throughout our bathrooms.

4. Sorting and reducing food, consumable, and maintenance waste

- Collective waste collection organised by category: glass, plastic, metal, paper, cardboard, etc.
- Reduction in the purchase of individual consumables.
- Eco-labelled and fair-trade food products offered.

5. Maintaining the quality of the property's living environment

- Smoking prohibited throughout all communal areas of the hotel, as well as in individual rooms.

6. Care of our green spaces and gardens

- Pesticides banned from the maintenance of green spaces.
- Native plant species used in the gardens.
